

Copy of letter from Miss Paula Schäfer*

Harunje, January 2, 1916

Dear Mr. Peet:

We have sent you indirectly some letters and reports and we should like to know if you ever got them.

I hope we soon can give you a complete account of the sums you sent us. We are able to do a great deal and we hope to accomplish more and more.

Within the next weeks you will receive a detailed report about our work in December and January. Ten days ago I sent you a telegram for money. I suppose it will have arrived in Adana in the meantime. You surely heard from Mr. Jackson where we are working now. It is a hard, but beautiful task.

Perhaps we shall have to come and see you some time in order to talk over with you different matters, for we had all kinds of experiences during the last time.

For the New Year God's blessing to you and your whole work! We are deeply touched by our dear Dr. Shepard's death. He has been like a dear old father also to us. We shall miss him very much, especially in our new work.
